

# CEA IPv6 PlugFest | April 20-22, 2015 | Atlanta, GA

- The area airport is ATL, Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

## Location Information

The PlugFest is the **AT&T building at 725 W Peachtree Street** (“AT&T Midtown 2”). The entrance is on Cypress Street NE. See map below. \*\*\* *The PlugFest is **NOT** at 675 W Peachtree Street in the big AT&T tower, which is where everyone will direct you if you ask for directions to AT&T.* \*\*\*

“Peachtree Street” and “West Peachtree Street” are NOT the same street. They run parallel, a block or two apart. Over 50 streets in Atlanta have “Peachtree” in their name. Make sure the street name matches precisely.

## Hotels

There are 4 high-quality hotels nearby, within easy walking distance. Many other hotels are available that have easy [MARTA](#) access (MARTA is the local rapid-transit system). If you will be using MARTA, please consider getting a hotel on the North-South MARTA line, and not north of Lindbergh station.

Co-sponsor AT&T is providing the host location, at AT&T Midtown 2. The following nearby hotels have negotiated AT&T rates (make sure to mention AT&T when making your reservation):

## Shipping Information

Sending equipment to Atlanta:


The AT&T facility has a receiving center with a loading dock in the building. This is the most convenient place to ship equipment, should you wish to do so. **We'll send out specific shipping instructions in early March** (such as how to address the package). If you are shipping from overseas, you will need to note that you are maintaining full ownership of the equipment.

Returning equipment to your home location:

You will be responsible for return shipping costs. Return shipping information will also be available in early March.

## Map

This map has hotels indicated. The blue box is where we're meeting, and the North Avenue MARTA station is the station two blocks to the south. Our meeting place, 725 W Peachtree St (Midtown 2), is just north of the MARTA station, on the other side of 3rd St. The main entrance is on Cypress Street NE.



## Getting Around

Here are some transportation options.

### MARTA

MARTA is Atlanta's public transportation system. It is the best way to get around the city (however, it doesn't run from 1am to 5am). Single trips are \$2.50/ride + \$1.00 for the rechargeable card (one time purchase). If you arrive at the airport during "normal" hours, there are usually many MARTA employees ready and willing to help you and answer your questions.

It's a direct ride from the airport to the North Avenue (N3) MARTA station. All trains from the airport go to North Avenue (and all southbound trains go to the airport). Trains run every 5 to 10 minutes, depending on time of day. It takes about 20 minutes from the airport to North Avenue. The station is in the basement of the AT&T Center. Exit to the north (follow signs to "AT&T Center"), unless going to Crowne Plaza. *[Note: We aren't meeting at the AT&T Center – we're meeting across the street at the AT&T Midtown 2 building at 725 W Peachtree St., with main entrance on Cypress St.]*

### Taxi

The taxi rate between the airport and Midtown (where we're meeting) is a flat \$32 + \$2 for each additional person (plus tip). This is a published, negotiated rate, so don't let them charge a higher rate. Some people find that walking from MARTA to a hotel at midnight is an uneasy experience, so please consider this when planning your local transportation.

### Car

If you prefer renting or driving a car, there are a variety of pay-to-park lots around. There's no free parking available. Parking at the AT&T venue is about \$5.
